Meg Lee is now one of the North West's most popular and in demand contemporary jazz singers, and has played on Clare Teals BBC Radio 2 Jazz Show, shared stages with acts including Rumer, Kat Eaton and appeared at Ronnie Scott's.

The Heidi Browne Band - The Shroppie Fly 4PM

After a truly wonderful performance at last year's festival, Heidi returns for her second appearance of the weekend, this time ably accompanied by her band. 





Katie & The Bad Sign - The Bridge Inn 4PM







Jim Kirkpatrick - The Shroppie Fly 4.30PM


